
Deacon Donnie E. Davis Journeyman Scholarship Application Package





A Journeyman is an individual who has completed an apprenticeship and is fully educated in a trade or craft.

Purpose

Deacon Donnie Davis, a native of Mississippi, served in the U.S. Air Force as a trained sheet metal machinist. He received additional education and specialized skills in vocations such as air-conditioning and refrigeration, welding, carpentry, mechanical, and electrical.

He was employed at Chrysler and worked 30 years at Griffin International where he retired as sheet metal supervisor. As a leader and ambassador for change, he was self-motivated and was always found seeking ways to simplify, beautify, fix, repair, and make things better in his church, home, family, and community.

He had a love for teaching and mentoring. He often encouraged others to pursue a vocational skill for gainful employment and sustainability.

Applicant Qualification Guidelines and Procedures

Applicant must:

- Be a graduating high school senior or have a GED;
- Have a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or above;
- Enroll as a full-time student in an accredited post-secondary vocational institution;
- Submit a completed application form;
- Submit a signed and written letter of recommendation by a School Teacher, GBTC Sunday School Teacher or Sunday school support Staff;
- Submit an up-to-date *official* transcript (*sealed*); and
- Complete the Journeyman Scholarship questionnaire.

All eligible applicants for the Deacon Donnie E. Davis Journeyman Scholarship must submit a complete application package to the GBTC Sunday school superintendent's office or mail to the address listed below. All applications must be received by **June 1**. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.
